In reality, God is the basis for absolute morality. When you throw out God (that is, God as revealed in the Bible), you throw out the things that God gives us, including an objective right and wrong. If materialistic evolution is true, then our actions are determined entirely by our environment and physical brains, ruled by the laws of physics, as even the leading evolutionist William Provine (1942–2015) has admitted.

Dawkins, in one of his more typical moods, said that we inhabit a universe which has “no design, no purpose, no evil and no good, nothing but blind, pitiless indifference.”⁴ Where, in this worldview, is there any room to say that what these Muslim terrorists have done is “wrong”? And how were the atheistic mass-murdering dictators of the last century “wrong” for that matter—they were being *consistent* with a worldview that lacks ultimate right and wrong.
